
Just after the last newsletter at the end of October, Typhoon Tino devastated the city of Cebu in the Central Visayas, Philippines with disastrous flooding resulting in utter devastation and over 200 deaths (photo).



Shortly after that Super Typhoon Uwan threatened to devastate Pastor Roans home town of Las Navas and the province of Northern Samar with the National Government issuing a High Level Alert notice (photo).



Roan contacted me on FaceTime on the morning of 8 November and with Cebu fresh in his mind was clearly worried and asked for prayer for protection. I urgently emailed a number of donors and asked for prayer. I then monitored the typhoon all day on Zoom Earth and noted a cheese wedge shaped gap in the rain on the radar over Roans town of Las Navas (photo). I monitored the rain all day and the wedge barely moved



despite the typhoon progressing. Other than some minor wind damage to the Pambujan Church and one or two houses there was no serious damage, injuries or deaths within any of Roans church group although some other locals were affected then assisted. A truly remarkable answer to prayer. All glory to the Lord.

In addition significant unsolicited donations resulted and we were able to send sums to Pastors Roan, Ariel and Nelia to assist with reparations and relief for the aftermath of this and other recent natural events. Praise God !

Elsewhere, it was reported that the ISIS perpetrators of the Bondi Beach massacre had previously visited an ISIS training camp on Mindanao where most of our supported churches are located. Thankfully our Pastors have good relationships with local police and army who often support them on gospel outreaches and the work goes on with positive results as you can read in the following pages from which I hope you find encouragement. Shalom! Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, Our soon coming King and reigns. We are so grateful to the Lord for your constant prayers and support for our Ministry here in the Philippines.

As you will know from from mainstream and social media our country has been experiencing different calamities such as Typhoons, Earthquakes and Land-slides in both the Visayas and Mindanao Islands.

Last October 17,2025 an Earthquake and Landslides hit Mindanao, including our neighbourhood with some people missing and dead due to those calamities.

The House of our Pastor in Dumingag was damaged by the 6.5 Magnitude quake. The Lord enabled me to travel along Mindanao areas, to visit Churches



and help our Brethren who were affected (photos).

We are planning to travel to the one of the far municipalities in our Province to a remote Barangay (Parish) where there are a lot of Rebel Soldiers that camp in that area and no Christian Church but the Lord has opened doors for us to have contact and opportunities to Minister to them. The Local Government in that area

is backing us up with the Police and Military. But most of all the King of kings and the Lord of lords will be with us. (*Philip note: The relationship with the local police is invaluable. See photo of Ariel sharing a radio programme with a local police sergeant*).



Many of our Brethren were also badly affected in Cebu Province by the said calamities. But we Thank God for sparing us here in our place. We are sending some financial

support to some of our Brethren who were affected there.

This Month of November is also our preparation for our Annual Year End Thanksgiving and Church Anniversary Celebration here in our local Church. We praise the Lord that after these Calamities that hit our Country that we can continue in ou Service to Him and to His people that He entrusted to us.

By next year 2026 ,God willing we will start to build our Church Building in Barangay Tuluan, Midsalip in our new Location. Please include in your prayers that God sends the right person to Shepherd the flocks of God in the Mountain areas.

December On the First week of December I was invited to Share the Word of God in one our Network Pastor churches in Maguindanao, South Cotabato, a muslim area, for their Church Anniversary Celebration. We Praise God for the success of the said events and also for our safety travel from Ozamis to Maguindanao and back.



In the Second week we had our Children General Feeding outreach in our local Church, Then after that said Ministry we had prayer and fasting as preparation for our Church Anniversary and Thanksgiving Celebration there in the Church in Dumingag, Zamboanga.

On December 28 we had our Thanksgiving and Church Anniversary here in our Local Church,

Despite many troubles like earthquake, typhoons and government struggles in my country we continue in serving the Lord.

This month we continue with public evangelism through the help of the government officers and continue the kids ministry, evangelism, visiting Churches and helping people who are in need especially to the senior citizen who is very poor which no one cares them. Here in my village so many Senior citizens are lack of medical care. The Lord put into my heart praying that God will used our ministry to help the old people who are in need of serious medication even just to feed them monthly. And that it can be arranged for a free check-up by a public doctor to check them. And this month we shared 10 bags of rice to the seniors whose age is 80 above (photo) and they were very happy of receiving it during the public community meeting. My heart is sad because there are some senior citizens who are in serious need of foods. My vision is to plant a seeds of the gospel that they must believe the Lord because most of them believing in a cult doctrine. Please pray with me in this vision to connect the elderly in my village.



Also, we have been helping built the Tribal Church in Antonino by bringing as volunteers the orphan boys who live with me and work with me in the ministry. I gave them supplies of rice for 2 to 3 days (photo) and clothing for the children because they were struggling too much since the flood devastating them. Right now they are still fighting to live again and praise God during our visit to their area the Lord touches their heart to remain calm and trust Him in season and out of season.
