In April **Sister Nelia** contacted me to say that regular power cuts in their mountain village was impacting the ministry. We established how much a standby generator would cost and subsequently made a donation to cover the cost (*photo of Nelia with the generator*). So the ministry and the church are able to continue functioning when the rest of the village is plunged into darkness. Very biblical

as the light of Christ shines out. As the Lord as quoted in John 8:12 said 'I AM THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD. HE WHO FOLLOWS ME SHALL NOT WALK IN DARKNESS, BUT HAVE THE LIGHT OF LIFE'. I pray that you are encouraged by these and the other accounts in this newsletter. Grateful thanks for your prayer support and donations which achieve much for the Lord.


Pat writes: My heart that is overflowing with thankfulness, to thank you all for your continued faithfulness in supporting our ministry. Your prayers, words of en-








